- **Mentorship Scholarship** (Available to **all** students. We seek students that might not otherwise apply or qualify for a scholarship. Award amounts vary)
- **Jeneanne Ericsson Photography Scholarship** (Available to student with an interest in photography. \$1000)
- **Tomas Acuña Scholarship** (Available to past Cali students on the reduced or free lunch program who have a desire to become a teacher. \$500)
- **ATP Group Scholarship for Enology, Viticulture, Fermentation Science or Wine Business related studies.** (\$1000)

- Review of applications: March 2018
- Notify Recipients of Award: First Week of April 2018. We will call or email if you are awarded a scholarship
- Presentation of Award: May 2018 exact date TBD by the High School.

- What are your current educational goals? What degree/certification are you pursuing?
